Cinema in the City will explore how cinematographers and filmmakers use the moving image to interpret the urban landscape. Students will develop their own moving image aesthetic by creating a short film that explores the contemporary urban environment of downtown Portland through pictures and sound. By the end of the 2 weeks, students will know how to: (1) Shoot on 16mm film (2) Hand process 16mm film (3) Record and edit sound for cinema (4) Digitally edit a cinematic cityscape.</p>
